

**Resolutions passed in the KHNA Interim General
Body 2025 with more than 2/3rd (Two-Third) majority**

March 8th, 2025

Resolution 1:

All Future convention venues (Nagar) should be named: SWAMI SATHYANANDA SARASWATHY NAGAR.

Resolution 4:

Proposed Amendment for Interim General Body of KHNA

Title: Resolution to Reassess, Align, and Uphold KHNA Bylaws

Summary:

This resolution seeks to reaffirm KHNA's core mission of promoting Sanatana Dharma and supporting Hindu families in North America while ensuring that its bylaws reflect transparency, unity, and inclusivity. To achieve this, a reassessment of all bylaw amendments made since 2015 will be conducted. During this review, a moratorium will be placed on post-2015 amendments, and KHNA will temporarily operate under the pre-2015 Bylaw framework.

Rooted in the traditions of Sanatana Dharma, this resolution emphasizes that KHNA's actions and policies remain lawful, ethical, and focused on fostering harmony and understanding. The General Body is reaffirmed as the supreme authority, with collective decisions aimed at preserving the organization's integrity and community values.

Action Requested:

Approval of this resolution to:

- Initiate a comprehensive review of all post-2015 amendments.
- Temporarily revert to the pre-2015 Bylaw framework until the assessment is complete.
- Reaffirm KHNA's commitment to its guiding principles of Sanatana Dharma, transparency, and unity.

Resolution 5:

Subject: Revision of Objectives and Establishment of a Family Forum

Resolution:

1. Revision of KHNA Objectives:

The General Body resolves to update the core objectives of KHNA to better reflect its mission and values. The revised objectives are as follows:

- To promote and uphold the principles of Sanatana Dharma.
- To provide spiritual, cultural, and emotional support to Kerala Hindu families in North America.
- To conduct religious, cultural, educational, and charitable activities that foster global harmony and understanding.
- To safeguard and advocate for Hindu values while promoting inclusivity and lawful practices in alignment with the organization's principles.

2. Establishment of a Family Forum:

The General Body further resolves to establish a Family Forum as a standing committee under Article 5.14 of the KHNA bylaws.

Purpose of the Family Forum:

- To address the spiritual, cultural, and emotional needs of Hindu families in North America.
- To organize activities such as family retreats, counseling sessions, and cultural awareness programs.
- To foster intergenerational connections within the Hindu community.
- To promote family-centered values aligned with Sanatana Dharma principles.

Structure and Reporting:

- The Family Forum shall be chaired by a member of the Board of Directors, with additional members appointed based on their interest and expertise.
- The committee shall submit quarterly reports to the Board of Directors and an annual report to the General Body.

Budget:

- The Family Forum shall present its proposed budget for approval to the Board of Directors.

Justification:

This resolution aligns with KHNA's mission to support Hindu families and promote Sanatana Dharma principles. By revising the objectives and creating a dedicated Family Forum, KHNA can better address the evolving needs of its members and strengthen its impact.

Resolution 6:

Subject: Conflict of Interest and Ethical Conduct

Resolution:

No dignitary / official of KHNA shall concurrently hold a leadership position in any organization whose objectives, activities, or affiliations conflict with or parallel those of KHNA, including entities linked to domestic or international federal affiliations. Should such a conflict of interest arise, the individual's affiliation with KHNA will be deemed invalid.

If the individual refuses to relinquish their conflicting position, the KHNA Board of Directors, by a majority vote, may suspend the individual's authority until the issue is resolved or until the provisions outlined in Article 6.8 are invoked for permanent removal.

Furthermore, any individual found engaging in unethical activities with the intent to undermine KHNA's mission, values, or principles of dharma, or to create rivalry against the organization, shall be immediately removed from their position of authority.

This resolution is proposed to ensure KHNA's integrity, uphold its principles, and safeguard its mission from any internal or external threats.
